Score-15 Scoring Template

This is to enable collection of an outcome measure locally.

The original SCORE 15 should be sent to the research coordinator, and does not need to be scored in any way.

Scoring is for local information and data collection. Keep a copy of the SCORE15 form

Into the excel sheet, SCORE-15 SCORING TEMPLATE

Simply enter the correct score (xery wellqas 1 and not at allqas 5)

for each of the 15 questions into the column headed ±tem scoreg.

There is no need to reverse negative scores. Your new scores will overwrite the ±worked example qalready in the sheet.

The score you type in for each question will automatically populate the dimension columns, providing the individual dimension scores.

The template already has formulas within it to do all the sums.

Then simply save as Site Code+Family Number; print and attach to the copy of the SCORE15 questionnaire you are keeping. **Send the original SCORE-15 to your research coordinator**

If you prefer, you can print the template and score by hand but then you have to do the maths!
